






Southwark is ethnically diverse.




52% of the population belong to the White group, **48%** to Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic group.

Southwark Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic Structure, 2015









2015 Ward Population Structure Southwark



The Four E's Discipleship Pathway






