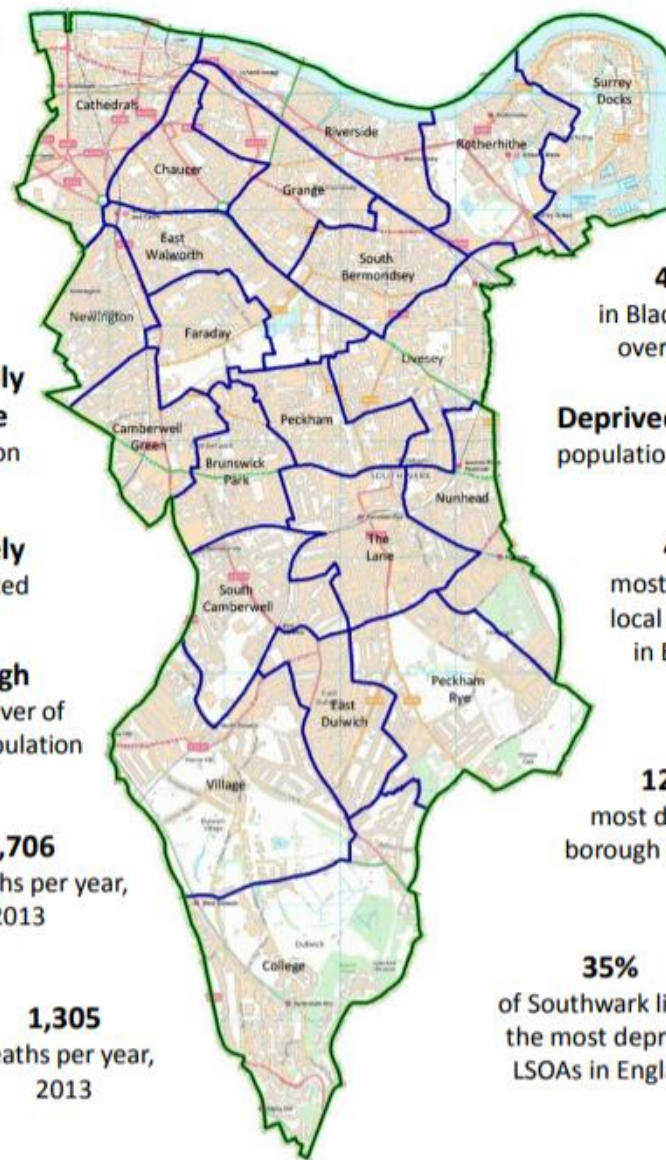

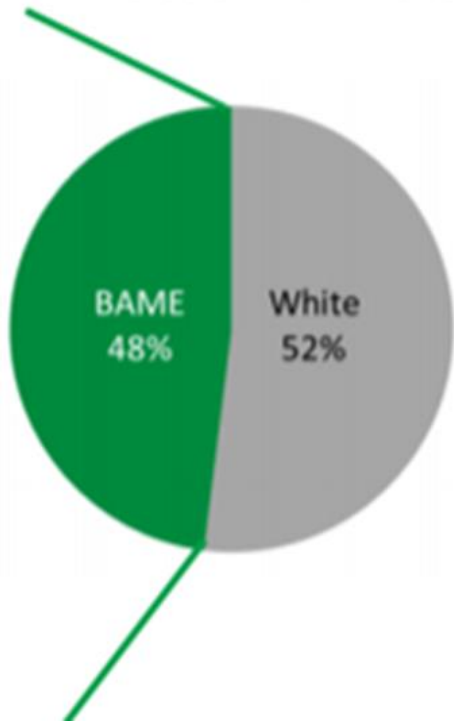

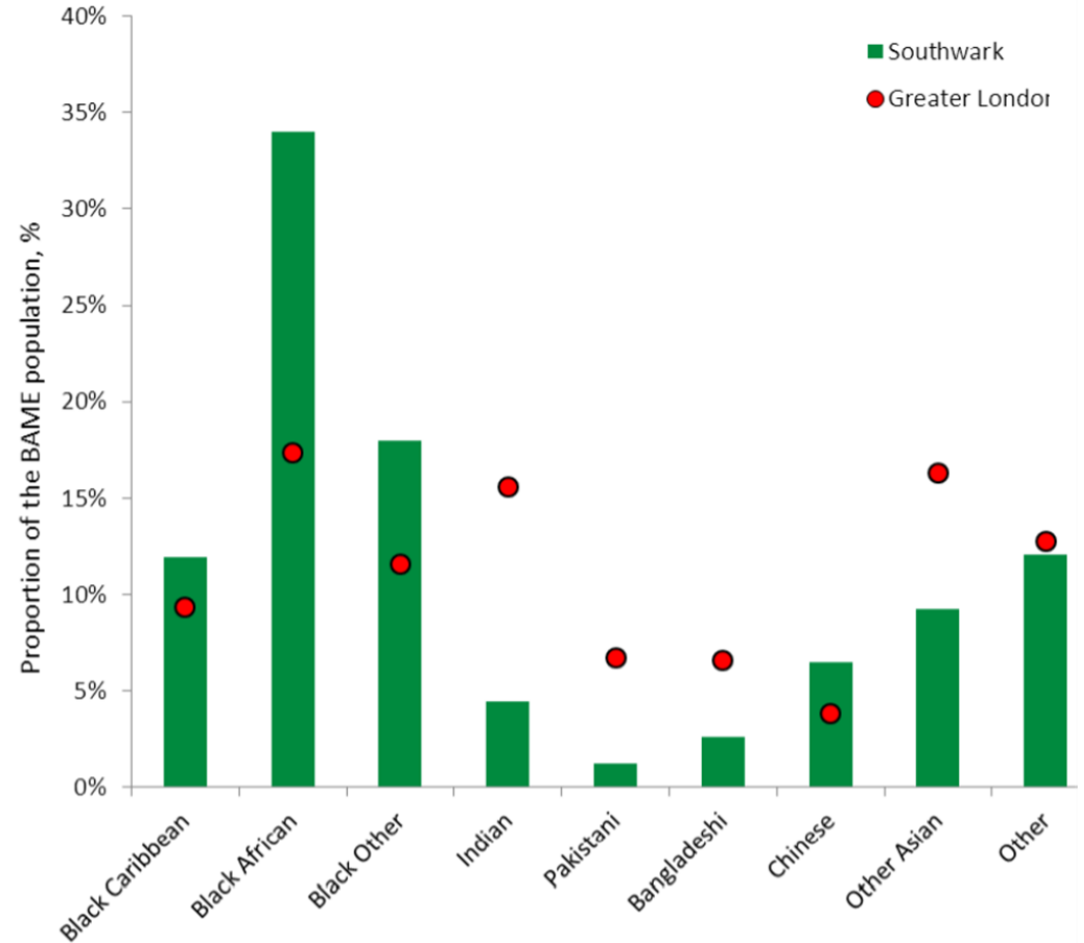

Southwark is ethnically diverse.



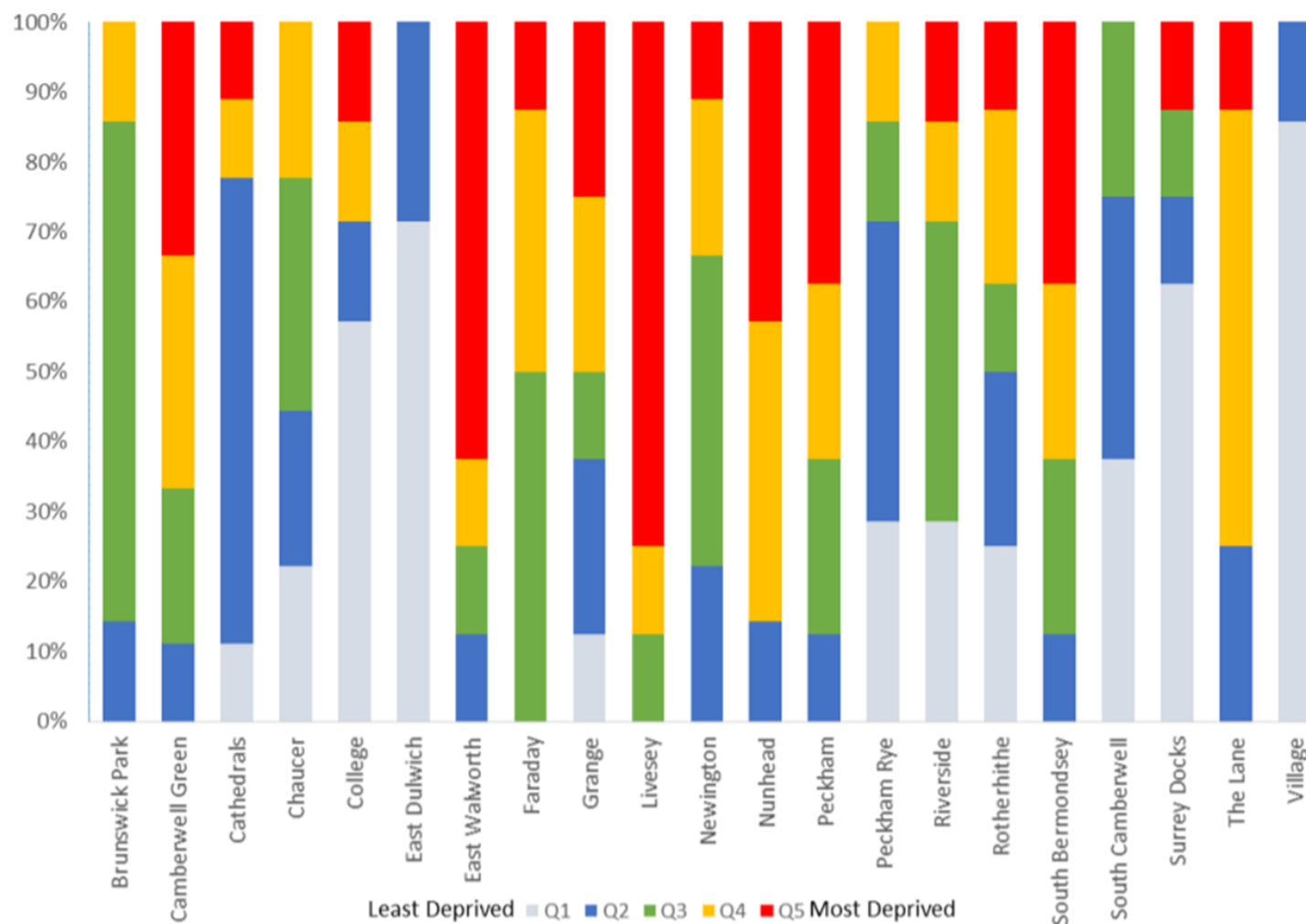
52% of the population belong to the White group, **48%** to Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic group.

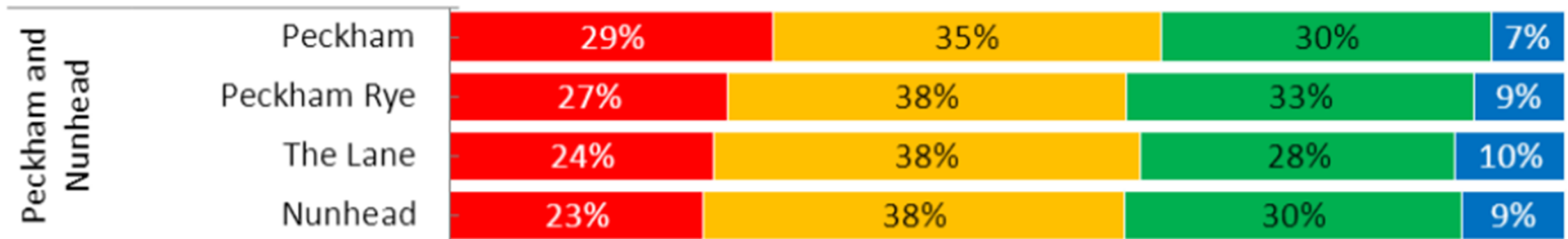
2015 Ward Population Structure Southwark

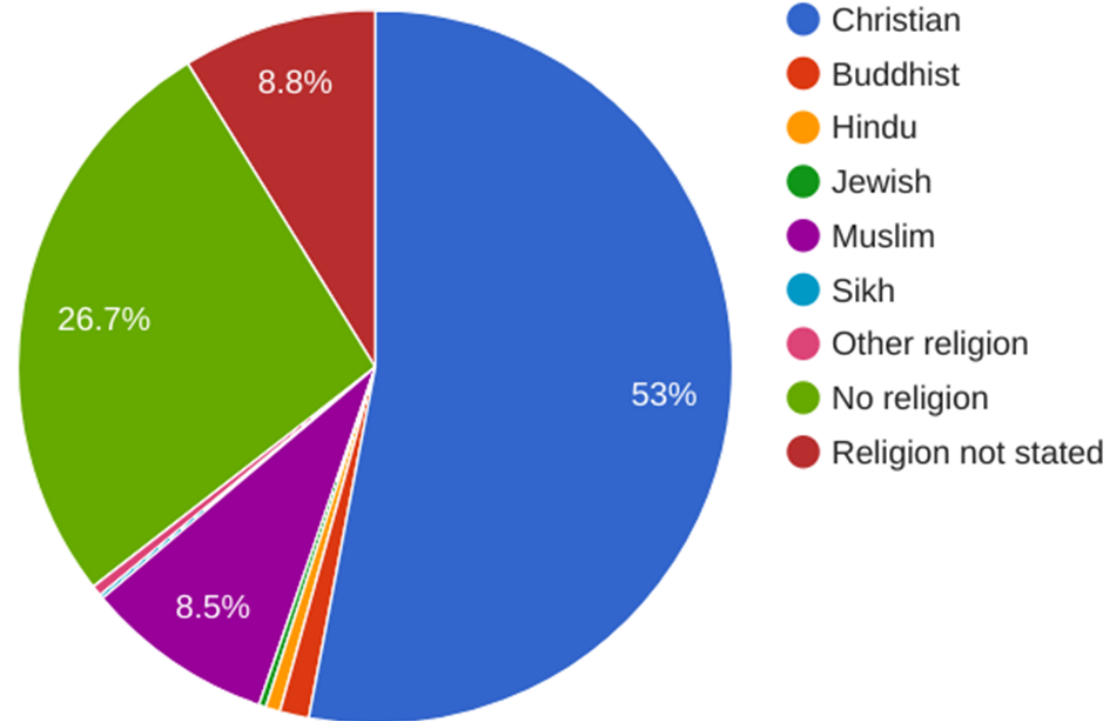
