Indicatives → Imperatives (with indicatives)

Baptising them → Teaching them to obey (from the Scriptures)

- 1 Blessing from the Father
- 2 Access to the Father
- 3 Praying to the Father
- 4 One Father
- 5 As dearly loved children... Giving thanks to the Father
- 6 Peace from the Father

Metaphors of church – body, building, bride, brotherhood

Esp. The new body \rightarrow The growth of the body

Gospel to the praise of his glory (1:6, 12, 14)

Eyes opened to see → fullness

Gospel on display in church (3:10)

Power to grasp → fullness → glory in the church & in Christ Jesus

Whole measure of fullness of Christ
