

- Residents span across multicultural suburban families to young professionals & students










Our story

Current resources



- **Physical building**: Main hall plus 3 breakout spaces (1 currently unusable), car park, prominent location
- Capacity per service: 90 chairs in main hall, with room for ~50 more
- Staff: 1 Vicar + 1 intern
- Existing St Augustine's Congregation: ~30 members
- Volunteers:
 - Graft Team (~20 adults, 2 kids) permanently relocating from
 CCM + others locally
 - SWAT (Serving, Willing, & Temporary) helping intermittently as needed
- Co-mission support: prayer, financial, etc.



Two services, one church



10.30am Traditional Service



- Traditional service, with organ music and Anglican liturgy
- Geared towards current congregation of traditionally Anglican and age >50+
- Expected mix will be predominantly >50, but we will focus on rebuilding the Sunday school to encourage more kid/family friendly attendance

4pm Contemporary Service



- Contemporary service with music band
- Geared towards students & young professionals living in new developments (8k newly built flats in the area)
- Expected mix will be younger, but eventually we would like to encourage young families by offering Sunday school at the 4pm service as well




